* Certain generic medications within the Generic Trial Program are limited to a specific strength(s).

The first time you fill a prescription for one of these medications, your copayment will be waived for the first 6-months. This applies to new prescriptions or when switching from an existing prescription to one of these medications. Future prescriptions will be subject to the usual copayment amount.

How does the Generic Trial Program work?

- Ask your health care provider to write a prescription for one of the generic medications included in the program.
- You are permitted a free 6-month trial per medication within the program.
- The cost of all future prescriptions are your responsibility and will be at the usual generic copayment/coinsurance amount.
- If you are enrolled in the University HSA-eligible Plan, your deductible must be met before the Generic Trial Program will apply.
