What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	In-Network: \$1,650 Individual/ \$3,300 Family; Out-of-Network: \$1,815 Individual/ \$3,630	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> must be met before the plan begins to pay.
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Yes, <a href="#">Preventive Care</a>	This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. But a <a href="#">copayment</a> or <a href="#">coinsurance</a> may apply. For example, this <a href="#">plan</a> covers certain <a href="#">preventive services</a> without <a href="#">cost sharing</a> and before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> . What is not included in the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> ? **Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.**
